Improper moisture balance in patients with limited mobility can often increase skin vulnerability and contribute to pressure ulcer injuries.


### **Prevalence**

Hydrocolloid or foam dressings that offer cushioning can help relieve pressure on areas prone to injury.


Moisturizers can help hydrate the skin, helping to reduce the risk of tearing.
